INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS REGARDING SAFETY AND EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

LOCKDOWN! LOCKS, LIGHTS, OUT OF SIGHT!

WHEN THERE IS A THREAT INSIDE THE SCHOOL BUILDING:

- MOVE OUT OF SIGHT
- MAINTAIN SILENCE - REMEMBER TO SILENCE YOUR PHONE
- LISTEN TO YOUR TEACHER FOR DIRECTIONS
- DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR



LOCKOUT! SECURE THE PERIMETER

AN INCIDENT OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL BUILDING THAT RESULTS IN PERIMETER DOORS BEING LOCKED & CLOSED. "BUSINESS AS USUAL" INSIDE.

EVACUATE! TO PREDETERMINED LOCATION

IN THE EVENT THAT EVACUATION IS NECESSARY:

- BRING YOUR PHONE, BUT LEAVE OTHER BELONGINGS BEHIND
- FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS FROM YOUR TEACHER
- REPORT ANY MISSING OR INJURED STUDENTS TO AN ADULT



SHELTER! HAZARD AND SAFETY STRATEGY

LISTEN TO YOUR TEACHER FOR THE PROPER SAFETY STRATEGY

NATURAL DISASTER
TORNADO, EARTHQUAKE,
HURRICANE, FLOOD,
BLIZZARD, WILDFIRE, ETC

FACILITY SYSTEM FAILURE
GAS LEAK/EXPLOSION,
HEAT/BOILER BREAKDOWN,
WATER MAIN BURST, ETC.

ALL REPORTS OF POSSIBLE THREATS & STUDENT HARM WILL BE TREATED WITH CONFIDENTIALITY. SCHOOL PERSONNEL ARE AVAILABLE TO LISTEN TO YOU & YOUR CONCERNS.
