Mount Sinai Union Free School District Parents Right To Know

As a parent of a student in the Mount Sinai U.F.S.D., you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your child's classroom teachers, and requires us to give you this information about each of your child's classroom teachers:

- ➤ Whether the New York State Education Department has licensed the teacher for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.
- ➤ Whether the New York State Education Department has decided that the teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed under state regulations because of special circumstances.
- ➤ The teacher's college major; whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and, if so, the subject of the degrees.
- ➤ Whether any paraprofessionals provide service to your child and, if they do, their qualifications.

The Mount Sinai school district is pleased to inform you that all of our classroom teachers are duly certified by the New York State Education Department.
